When a Child or Staff Member **Becomes** Sick at Home or School:



- To reduce fear, anxiety, or shame related to isolation, the school will provide clear explanations of the procedures, including use of PPE and handwashing.
- · Symptomatic staff or students should seek COVID-19 testing from their regular physician or through the local public health authority.
- Parents will contact the school nurse to report any possible exposure or confirmed/suspected Covid-19 case. The school nurse will follow up with appropriate contact tracing when necessary.
- If they have a negative COVID-19 viral test (and if they have multiple tests, all tests are negative), they will remain home until 24 hours after fever is gone, without use of fever-reducing medicine, and other symptoms are improving.
- If they do not undergo COVID-19 testing and-have had no known exposure, the person should remain home until 24 hours after fever is gone, without use of fever reducing medicine, and other symptoms are improving

If a student or staff member is COVID positive:

Alert administrator and nurse immediately. Quarantine per CDC guidelines and do not come into work or school. Do not come into the building.

• If a student or staff receives a positive COVID-19 viral (PCR) test result the person will remain home for 5 days after illness onset and 24 hours after fever is gone, without use of fever reducing medicine, and other symptoms are improving, regardless of vaccination status. Upon returning, a student or staff member will need to wear a mask and eat in a designated area until 10 days from symptom onset.

COVID:

If you are classified as a close contact (within 6ft for a cumulative 15 min or more within 24 hours period) for any reason the following applies:

- If fully vaccinated (< 6 months ago with Pfizer or moderna, < 2 months ago with J&J), you do not need to be quarantined unless you present symptoms. Monitor daily for symptoms, continue coming to work and wear a mask for 10 days.
- If unvaccinated and both parties had masks on consistently and correctly, continue coming to work, mask, and monitor for symptoms daily for 5 days.
- · If unvaccinated and mask wearing was not present consistently and correctly for both parties, quarantine for 5 days (wear a mask upon returning for 5 days).
