

(Note: this policy was updated 7/28/15 by Moore Smith Buxton & Turcke, Chtd. However, the Board reviewed the updated policy and determined that the updates were not applicable to the IACS Board. Therefore, this policy was retained and not updated.)

NOMINATION OF BOARD MEMBERS

A nominating committee consisting of up to three (3) members shall be appointed by the Board of Directors (the Board) in January of each year. They will be responsible for collecting names and vita of persons desiring to run for election to the Board. Persons desiring to serve on the Board will have the opportunity to submit their resume and qualifications by one week before the annual meeting. The nominating committee will publish information about all candidates. The information will be available for voters at the annual meeting. In addition, nominations may be made from the floor at the annual meeting.

ELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Members of the Board shall be elected at the Annual Meeting of members, defined as all parents and legal guardians of students currently attending the Idaho Arts Charter School (IACS) and the founders. The Annual Meeting is to be held on the second Monday in May of each year.

At the Annual Meeting, the nominee(s) receiving the greatest number of votes of the members present shall be declared by the Board as the Board member(s) elected for that Board position.

If two or more nominees have the same number of votes for a single Board position, and a greater number than any other nominee for that Board position, the Board will determine the winner by the toss of a coin.
