Idaho Arts Charter School (IACS) will be a legally and operationally independent entity established by the nonprofit corporation's Board of Directors (Board). The elected Board will be legally accountable for the operation of IACS. The Board acknowledges that according to the approved petition, they are public agents required by the Nampa School District (NSD) to control IACS. IACS will comply with all federal and state laws and rules and acknowledges its responsibility for identifying essential laws and regulations, and complying with them.

This Board has the powers and duties attributed to it by the Constitution and laws of the State of Idaho. Individual members of the Board have no power separate from the Board as a whole. Members of the Board have authority only when acting as a Board legally in session.

The Board is not bound by any action or statement on the part of an individual Board member except when such statement or action is in pursuance to specific instructions from the Board.

No Board member, by virtue of his or her office, may exercise any administrative responsibilities with respect to IACS or, as an individual, command the services of any IACS employee.

IACS will not contractually bind the Nampa School District.
